Monday, March 4, 2019: Bus Leaves at 9:15am

The day begins with a guided tour of Sundance Square and downtown Fort Worth including the vivid history that made this city great. Be in the Stockyards in time to see the “running of the steer” (longhorn herd of cattle), at noon enjoy lunch at The Cattlemen’s Steakhouse and then learn about the history of the cattle industry at the Stockyards Museum or shop for souvenirs and/or custom-made cowboy boots. Return to the Omni with time to explore The Near Southside district or rest up for the Monday night social at (optional) Rahr Brewery.

Start the day at the Log Cabin Museum – an interactive look at historic Fort Worth. Next, enjoy a guided tour of Fort Worth’s cultural district with history of the many museums. Split into 2 groups with the first group eating a buffet lunch at The Kimbell Museum of Art followed by a tour of Bernardo Bellotto’s Grand Scene – Paintings that will transport the viewer to the splendor of Eighteenth-Century Dresden and the second group touring the museum and then enjoying the buffet lunch. The permanent collection that includes Michelangelo’s first painting is also available. Return to the Omni with lots of time to prepare for the formal dinner.
